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PROSTATE BIOPSY INSTRUCTION SHEET

INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BIOPSY

1. Take the oral antibiotic pill 90 minutes before the test.

2. Please give yourself a **Fleet's enema** on the day of the biopsy. The Fleet's enema may be purchased at any drug store. If the rectum is not stool-free, it may be necessary to reschedule the procedure.

3. You **must eat** a regular diet the day of the procedure.

4. <u>TELL THE DOCTOR IF YOU TAKE ASPIRIN, ANTI-INFLAMMATORIES*, COUMADIN,</u> <u>PERSANTINE, OR PLAVIX BECAUSE THOSE DRUGS MUST BE STOPPED BEFORE</u> <u>BIOPSY. IT IS ESSENTIAL TO BE OFF THESE MEDICINES FOR *ONE WEEK* PRIOR TO <u>THE BIOPSY.</u></u>

- 5. Please stop taking any vitamins, herbal supplements, or teas 1 week prior to biopsy.
- 6. All biopsies and ultrasounds are performed in the **Yorba Linda** office.

INSTRUCTIONS AFTER BIOPSY

1. If you have any fever of 100.6 degrees or greater following the biopsy over the subsequent 3 or 4 days, please report this to the doctor IMMEDIATELY day or night.

2. You might see a small amount of blood at the beginning or end of urination. This is to be expected. Call if the bleeding is continuous of persistent.

- 3. If you have rectal bleeding or bleeding with a bowel movement, please notify the doctor.
- 4. Refrain from heavy lifting or strenuous activity (including golf) for 72 hours after the biopsy.
- 5. NO intercourse for 72 hours after the biopsy.
- 6. Expect blood in the semen for at least 6 to 8 weeks after the biopsy.

*such as Motrin, Ibuprofen, Aleve, Indocin, Clinoril, Naprosyn (Vioxx and Celebrex are allowed).
